The Associate Dean for Research is responsible for communicating the goals and needs of the college's research to various stakeholders to advance the college in its pursuit of excellence in research.

Policy, Procedure and Evaluation Oversight

- Assemble and lead a Council of Principal Investigators and support research efforts in the College. Assist in developing a community of scholars in HHP.
- Identify and develop research opportunities.
- Approve all research proposals on behalf of the Dean and uphold the College's interests and rights in IDC distributions. Advise the Dean regarding Indirect Cost generation and distribution.
- Provide guidance to faculty and staff in administration of external research funding.
- Oversee policies and procedures governing startup/incentive grants programs in the college, faculty research, bonus plan, bridge funding opportunities, and intellectual property rights. Serve as College compliance officer on issues of research misconduct.
- Promote research integrity central to the College's mission or serve as Ombudsman regarding research conduct issues.
- Provide leadership on legislative proposal requests, Division of Sponsored Research Opportunity Fund Proposals, and limited application programs for the College.
- Serve on various college committees including Administrative Council and College Council.
- Work closely with the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs on internal faculty awards (UFRF Professorship and Doctoral Mentoring) related to research.
- Create, design, and publish College Research Annual Report for distribution.
- Oversee the Office of Research and College's research web page.
- Promote high-impact scholarship in the College. Calculate and summarize science metrics on publishing and H-index annually.
- Advise the Dean regarding Center/ Institute development and oversee the evaluation process and reports of Centers/ Institutes.
