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Danny Ramsey Ballard is a professor of Health Education in the Department of Health and Kinesiology at Texas A&M University, where she is Associate Department Head and Chair of the Health Education Division. She is a former public school teacher in the Houston, Texas area. Dr. Ballard teaches graduate and undergraduate courses on women's health. In addition to co-authorship of *Contemporary Women's Health: Issues for Today and the Future*, soon to be in its 4th edition, she also was co-author of an elementary textbook series entitled *Health*. She has published multiple research papers, technical papers, book chapters, and other professional materials; has made more than 230 national, regional, and state presentations. She has been the co-principal investigator and consultant of over \$1.7 million in funded projects. Dr. Ballard is past president of the American Alliance for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance (AAHPERD) and Southern District AHPERD. She is a Fellow in the American Association for Health Education (AAHE) and American School Health Association. She was named Outstanding Health Educator of the Year at both the national, district and state levels for AAHE. She most recently received the AAHPERD Honor Award. Dr. Ballard is the current holder of the Leonard D. Ponder Endowed Chair at Texas A&M University, which includes a one million dollar endowment.
