

A 3.0 UF GPA (most programs require a higher GPA) is necessary to enroll in graduate coursework during the junior and/or senior year for a single graduate degree. To apply the graduate credit to a master's degree, you must meet admission requirements of the Graduate School and all graduate coursework must be completed with grades of B or better. Contact the graduate coordinator for details.

Double-counted credit: Double-counted credits are those that a student earns in a degree program that are also applied to (or counted toward) another degree program. These are sometimes referred to as overlapping or shared credits. Graduate credits can be counted toward the undergraduate degree.
