LEI 6905—Directed Independent Study (1-5 credits; max: 10 credits) Individual projects under faculty guidance. Letter grade.

LEI 6910—Supervised Research (1-5 credits; max: 5 credits) S/U grade.

LEI 6940—Supervised Teaching (1-5 credits; max: 5 credits) S/U grade.

LEI 6971—Research for Master's Thesis (1-15 credits) S/U grade.

LEI 7904—Advanced Readings in Recreation, Parks and Tourism (1-3 credits; max: 6 credits) *Prereq: Intended for doctoral students.* S/U. Selected independent in-depth readings on a specific topic, which will be supervised and evaluated.

LEI 7905—Advanced Independent Study in Recreation, Parks and Tourism (1-3 credits; max: 6 credits) *Prereq: Intended for doctoral students.* Individual projects under faculty guidance. Letter grade.

LEI 7910—Advanced Supervised Research (1-5 credits; max: 5 credits) *Prereq: Intended for doctoral students. Not open to students who have taken 6910.* S/U grade.

HLP 7979—Advanced Research (1-12 credits) Research for doctoral students before admission to candidacy. S/U grade.

HLP 7980—Research for Doctoral Dissertation (1-15 credits) *Prereq: Doctoral students admitted to candidacy.* S/U grade.
